Suitable prizes will be offered for BEST IN SPECIALTY, BEST PUPPY IN SPECIALTY, 2ND, 3RD AND 4TH IN GROUP, BEST OF BREED, BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX, BEST PUPPY IN BREED, BEST ALTERED IN GROUP AND BREED, BEST BRACE IN SPECIALTY, BEST TEAM IN SPECIALTY, STUD DOG AND GET, and BROOD BITCH AND PROGENY. BEST OF BREED, SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER – MARY THORÉN TROPHY.

Awards of Merit will be offered for every 10 dogs competing at Breed level, at the judge's discretion

JUNIOR HANDLING: Suitable prizes will be awarded for PeeWee, Junior, Intermediate and Senior winning handlers. Best Overall and Reserve Junior Handling prizes will be awarded. Registration for **Junior Handling** must be completed at least one hour before scheduled judging. Dogs competing in **Junior Handling** must be entered in regular classes or in Exhibition Only. **A fee of \$2.00 for Junior Handling is required at the time of registration.**

BORDER TERRIER CANADA, SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER ASSOCIATION OF CANADA and WIRE FOX TERRIER CLUB OF CANADA will offer suitable prizes for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Veteran, Best of Winners, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and Best Puppy.

OBEDIENCE AWARDS

Prizes will be presented to Terriers (Group 4) at the Halifax Kennel Club Obedience and Rally-O Trials on Saturday, August 30, 2008, as follows: a prize will be awarded to the terrier with the highest qualifying score in Obedience, and to the terrier with the highest qualifying score in Rally-O.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All entries and entry fees are to be in the hands of the Show Secretary by the closing date and time.
2. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. N.S.F. cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees, an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellations of awards. N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 surcharge.

RULES

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the

CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian funds" or "At par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

CATALOGUES On a pre-order basis only. Please remit \$10.00 per catalogue with entries. Catalogues will not be mailed to exhibitors who are absent.

CLASSES

The following Regular Official C.K.C. classes, divided by sex, will be provided:

Junior Puppy	Dogs at least 6 months and under 9 months, on day of show.
Senior Puppy	Dogs at least 9 months and under 12 months, on day of show.
12-18 months	Dogs at least 12 months and under 18 months, on day of show.
Canadian Bred	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.
Bred by Exhibitor	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.
Open Class	All dogs 6 months of age or older.
Veterans	Dogs 7 yrs of age and over on day of show. May be spayed or neutered
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions.
Altered Dog Class	Dogs and bitches over 6 mos, sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Brace	Two dogs of the same breed on one leash
Team	Four dogs of the same breed on one leash.
Stud Dog & Get	Comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his get.
Brood Bitch & Progeny	Comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny.
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over, not for competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.

Dogs competing in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. Get and Progeny must be entered in a Regular Class.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Dogs must be either registered with the C.K.C. or have an Event Registration Number (ERN). All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at (416) 675-5511 or Fax (416) 675-6506. A listing fee is payable with Entry Fees for any dog not having an individual Registration Number at closing date.
