A Listing fee of \$8.56 per dog per show must be included with Entry Fees if the entry does not include a CKC individual registration number.

Cheques and/or money orders are to be made payable to **TOY DOG CLUB OF NEWFOUNDLAND**. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.

Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of entry forms shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action by the CKC & cancellation of awards.

**NON REGULAR CLASSES** (All dogs need not be owned by the same person)

**STUD DOG:** For Stud dog & two of it's GET. GET must be entered in regular classes

**BROOD BITCH:** For Brood Bitch & two of it's GET. GET must be entered in regular classes

**BRACE CLASS:** May be same sex or one of each but must be owned by the same person

***As of Jan 1,2007 "dogs 3 mos of age & under 6 mos of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, provided that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes". These puppies will NOT be listed in the catalogue***

## **ENTRY INFORMATION**

- 1 No entry will be accepted unless all particulars required on an Entry Form are shown thereon. An incomplete entry form will be returned.
- 2 An entry will not be accepted unless accompanied by the required fees.
- 3 Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs. The Show Secretary cannot be responsible for checking the accuracy of entries.
- 4 The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entries subject to CKC Rules & Regulations.
- 5 Telephone & telegraph entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the CKC Board of Directors may otherwise authorize.
- 6 To comply with CKC Rules & Regulations, the Show Secretary will be unable to accept, alter or cancel entries after the closing date.
- 7 The address section of the Entry Form should be completed fully to facilitate the mailing of the Judging Schedule.

## **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All Dogs that are foreign owned & enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN does NOT register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes but enables a foreign born & foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC.

To obtain an ERN:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN. Include payment of \$55.00 in Canadian funds via personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. Non CKC members please note that if paying by cheque the cheque must be certified. Provide full return address. Faxed requests accepted with Visa or Mastercard. Please provide expiry date & signature.

An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation.

An extension will be granted if a written request is forwarded to the CKC.

## GROUP V SWEEPSTAKES

**Date: Friday, July 6,2007    Time:    5:00 pm**

This competition is open to all dogs from six months up to (but not including) 18 months of age, on the day of the sweeps, regardless of birthplace. All entries must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only in the Speciality.

For the purpose of judging, the dogs will be divided into six classes with all being grouped within each of six classes:

- 6 to 9 month (male & female)
- 9 to 12 month (male & female)
- 12 to 18 month (male & female)

For the final judging, the dogs placing first in each class will be brought together for the final placings : ie. Best in Sweepstakes, Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes & Best Puppy in Sweepstakes. All money received for entry fees will be pooled & divided as follows:

### **CLASS PLACEMENTS**

- 1st Place - 5% of entry fees, a Rosette & a suitable prize
- 2nd to 4th - a Rosette

### **FINAL PLACEMENTS**

- Best in Sweepstakes - 20% of entry fees, a Rosette & a suitable prize
- Best of Opposite Sex - 10% of entry fees, a Rosette & a suitable prize
- Best Puppy - 15% of entry fees, a Rosette & a suitable prize

The remainder of the fees received will be retained by the Club to defray costs. No listing fee is required for Sweepstakes entries.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1 On the day of the show the Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of the show which shall be governed by CKC Rules & Regulations.
- 2 After closing of the entries, an ID card & Judging Schedule will be mailed to each Exhibitor.
- 3 Identification cards must be presented at the entrance to the show premises, & only dogs properly entered in the show will be admitted.
- 4 The building will be open one hour before the show starts.
- 5 Dogs may be removed from the building when not required for further judging.
- 6 Judging will proceed without any dog which is not present when called by the Ring Steward.
- 7 The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs & exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs or patrons.
- 8 If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries fees will be made.
- 9 We regret that trailer hookups will not be available at the show site.
- 10 Judge officiating at a show held under CKC Dog Show Rules & Regulations shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, & it shall be the duty & obligation of the Club holding the show to see that these Rules & Regulations are effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of these Rules & Regulations, & the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it sees fit on receipt of a report indicating that these Rules & Regulations has been violated.
- 11 Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under CKC Rules & Regulations shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the show, & it shall be the duty & obligation of the Club holding the show to see that these Rules & Regulations are effectively carried out.
- 12 Any dog excused by the Judge, Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not after being excused compete in any class or for any awards for the remainder of the show.
