- Ø **DOUBLE CHECK YOUR ENTRY - Don't forget the Name & Registration Number of your dog.**
- Ø **The Listing Fee is payable with the entry fee if the dog does not have an individual CKC Registration Number. The Litter Registration Number is not acceptable.**
- Ø **Please ensure the Entry Form is no larger than 8½ by 5½ inches**
- Ø **It is the responsibility of every Exhibitor to be familiar with the CKC Rules governing these Events.**
- Ø **NOTE: In order for an exhibitor to claim the discount for multiple dogs ALL entries must be submitted together and at the same time. Exhibitor is defined as the owner/co-owner of the dog.**
- Ø *As of Jan 1,2007 "dogs 3 mos of age & under 6 mos of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, provided that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes". These puppies will NOT be listed in the catalogue.*

CHAMPIONSHIP POINT RATINGS

 LEAST A 2 POINT WIN AT THE BREED OR GROUP LEVEL**

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. A CKC Listing Fee of \$10.00 per dog per show or trial is payable with the entry fee if the entry form for the dog does not include its CKC Individual Registration Number.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
3. Tendering of a NSF cheque as payment of entry fees shall be considered to be non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
4. Entrants must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs. The Show/Trial Secretary will not be responsible for checking the accuracy of entries. Errors should be brought to the attention of the Show/Trial Secretary.
5. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entries subject to CKC Rules.
6. The Show/Trial Secretary will be unable to accept or cancel entries **after** the closing date.
7. Telephone and other electronically transmitted entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the CKC Board of Directors may otherwise authorize.
8. **PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR CONFORMATION & OBEDIENCE. IF PHOTOCOPYING FORMS, THEY MUST BE THE SAME SIZE AS THE ORIGINAL (8½ by 5½ inches).**
9. The address section of the Entry Form should be completed fully to facilitate speedy mailing of the Judging Schedule.
10. Every dog entered in a Championship Show, or a licensed Obedience Trial held under CKC Rules, except those breeds designated by the Board as being eligible to compete in the Miscellaneous Class, must be registered or eligible for registration in the Stud Book of the CKC.
11. The Entry Form must be completed in full. An incomplete entry form must be rejected by the show-giving club and returned to the designated owner or authorized agent. **Double check your entry !!! Do NOT FORGET TO INCLUDE THE DOG'S NAME AND REGISTRATION NUMBER.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. On the day of the show the Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of the show.
2. After closing of entries, a receipt, admission ticket and judging schedule will be mailed to the exhibitor.
3. Admission tickets must be presented at the entrance to the show/trial premises, and only dogs properly entered in the show or trial will be admitted.
4. The building will be open 1 hour before the show starts. **Please note that grooming space will be limited so exhibitors are asked to minimize the use of space for x-pens.**
5. Dogs may be removed from the building when not required for further judging.
6. Dogs **must not** be left in the building overnight.
7. Judging will proceed without any dog not present when called by the ring steward.
8. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of, an accident or other misfortune to either dogs or patrons.
9. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
10. We regret that trailer hook-ups **will not** be available at the show site.
11. **It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show & Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See 26.7 of Conformation Show Rules & Regulations)**
12. Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show or trial held under CKC rules shall not be subject to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the show or trial.
13. The show and trial grounds are defined as the exterior walls of St Kevin's Parish Hall, Main Road, (Goulds), St John's, NL
14. The authorities of the shows/trials may:
 - a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
 - b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show/trial building on account of disease or viciousness.
 - c) in the case of non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance.

No one shall have any claim or recourse against the organization holding the show/trial or any official connected therewith for the refusal of an entry.

JUNIOR HANDLING

1. Junior Handling will be held on Sunday, November 11, 2007 directly after Obedience
2. Entries will be received at the Show Secretary's desk **up to one (1) hour prior** to the scheduled time for the start of the competition.
3. The scheduled time for the competition will be listed in the Judging Schedule but will be held directly after Obedience..
4. Please complete the entry form available **at the show**. Fee is \$5.00
5. Every dog handled in the Junior Handling competition **must** be entered in one of the regular official classes, or entered for "Exhibition Only" in the Championship Show, or entered in the Obedience Trial, on the day of the Junior Handling competition.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, if they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank You.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All Dogs that are foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes, but enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC.

To obtain an ERN, do the following:

1. Include payment of \$50.00 in Canadian funds;
2. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada, please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates;
3. Provide your full return address;
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure your Visa or MasterCard number is legible and that you have included your expiry date and signature.

An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.
