Champions and Championship points – Chapter 21

Section 1: A dog awarded winners at a Championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 – 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be provided hereunder:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded winners also places in Group.

All class dog awarded best in show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

Conformation Classes

The official C.K.C. classes, divided by sex will be provided.

Enter one category only.

Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of the show.
Canadian Bred	A dog, which was born in Canada.
Bred By Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
Open Class	All Dogs.
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions only.
Exhibition	Dogs 6 months and over, not in the competition.

- All judging will commence at 9:00 am unless entries warrant an earlier start.
- The Abegweit Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be held responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- The Abegweit Kennel Club is not responsible for any articles that are lost or stolen.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict. Judging will not be delayed for exhibitors or handlers who fail to have their dog in the ring when required.
- The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows.
- Judges officiating at the shows, club officials, volunteers or show participants shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is enforced. Any infringement of this regulation will be promptly reported and suitable action will be taken.
- On site canteen services will be provided by Abegweit Kennel Club Ltd. Members.
- *Exhibitors intending to camp at the show site are not required to pay exhibition fees for dogs that will not be leaving the campsite during show times.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY as we will not be responsible for spelling errors made because of sloppy hand writing/printing or hard to read fonts.
2. To comply with C.K.C. regulations, we will be unable to accept, substitute, change or cancel any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time or once the entry limit is reached – which ever comes first.
3. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
4. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and handlers please note that full name and address of both owners and handlers must be filled in, and to whom ID's are to be sent must be specified.
5. Telephone and facsimile entries are prohibited under C.K.C. rules.
6. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
7. Only dogs eligible for C.K.C. registration or ERN # may enter these shows. The Abegweit Kennel Club Ltd. reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to C.K.C. rules.
8. All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering C.K.C. events require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the C.K.C. for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables the dog to be awarded titles by the C.K.C. Each dog must have it's own number. This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a C.K.C. event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed"; however, failure to apply for the ERN within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. 9. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour before the show by the owner or handler.
10. Listing fees are payable with entry fees for dogs that do not have their individual registration number at closing date. A litter registration is not acceptable.
11. Official C.K.C. entry forms must be used. Please photocopy the enclosed entry form if you require more than were supplied. You may also download extra entry forms from our website <http://www.geocities.com/abegweitkk>
12. No post dated cheques accepted. Any NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
13. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention US Exhibitors: *Personal cheques will be accepted, however they must be payable in US funds – for the full amount of the entry. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques “payable in Canadian funds” or “at par” as such items are not readily cleared through the banks and will be returned with entry.*
