REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans*	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

*Veterans may be altered.

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

ALTERED CLASS: Competition for sexually altered dogs will be offered.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his Get.

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny.

Brace Class – "This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead ". Ownership does NOT have to be identical.

Team Class - Same as for Brace but 4 dogs.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form, same as TKC

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Working Dog, Working Dog Excellent - age and sex combined. Best in each class will compete for Best Overall Working Dog.

Sled Dog, Sled Dog Excellent, Sled Dog Unlimited - age & sex combined. Best in each of these classes will compete for Best Overall Sled Dog.

WORKING DOG CLASSES – ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Working Dog Class (WD) & Working Dog Excellent Class (WDX)
1. Copy of title certificates must accompany all entries
 2. Males and females will compete together in all classes. Altered entries are eligible.
 3. Winners of each of these 2 classes will compete for Best Overall Working Dog.
 4. Entrants must compete at the "highest eligible level".

SLED DOG CLASSES - ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Sled Dog Class (SD); Sled Dog Excellent Class (SDX); Sled Dog Unlimited Class (SDU)

1. Requirements as per CKC Certificate Program. Copy of CKC title certificates **must** accompany all entries any dog that does not have a title may be exhibited if proof that said dog has met condition #1 above is submitted with the entry (e.g. completed Passport).
2. Males and females will compete together in all classes. Altered entries are eligible.
3. Winners of each of these 3 classes compete for Best Overall Sled Dog.
4. Entrants must compete at the "highest eligible level".

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS, VETERANS AND RESCUES (includes rosette)

Entrants are requested to provide a brief history of their dog. Please do not exceed 50 words in length.

Note: All dogs entered in the Non-Regular, Unofficial or Parades must be entered in an official class or for exhibition only.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class	for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months
Senior Class	for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months
12-18 Open	for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 to 9 years	for dogs 7 up to and including 9 years of age
10 to 12 year	for dogs 10 years of age up to and including 12 years of age
12+	for Dogs 13 years of age and older

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sweeps.

Note: Veterans may be altered.

Puppy and Veteran Sweeps Prizes

The prize money for both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes will be distributed as follows:

- 50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;
- 15% of the total sweeps entry fees and rosette will go to the Best in Sweeps;
- 10% of the total sweeps entry fees and rosette will go to the Best of Opposite in Sweeps
- 25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

SLED DOG SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Siberian Huskies over the age of 12 months. Males & Females judged together. Sled Dog titles not required however proof that the dog has run in harness must accompany the entry (copy of sled dog title, copy of sled dog passport or completed form below). A Best in Sweeps and a BOS in Sweeps is to be awarded.

The prize money for Sled Dog Sweepstakes will be distributed as follows:

- 50% of the entry fees will go to Best in Sled Dog Sweeps
- 25% of the entry fees will go to Best of Opposite in Sled Dog Sweeps
- 25% will be retained for administration purposes.

3 GENERATION SWEEPSTAKES

All 3 generation sweepstakes must consist of 3 consecutive generations per entry.

The prize money for Sled Dog Sweepstakes will be distributed as follows:

- 40% of the total sweeps entry fees for Best In Sweeps;
- 20% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to 2nd place;
- 10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to 3rd place;
- 5% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to 4th place
- 25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

CONFORMATION JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior Handling will be offered in conjunction with the Specialty for all classes. All Juniors must handle a Siberian Husky. Judge – Kim Ramey LeBlanc

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler or run through the building or stands
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling.
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The SHCC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight. Dogs will **not** be allowed in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show

Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)

- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The SHCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the SHCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The precincts of the show shall be the building and it's entrances.
