## **ENTRY INFORMATION**

1. All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. **Please type or print clearly.**
2. **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and handlers please note that **full name and address of owners MUST** be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. **(Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)**
3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
4. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trials Secretary after the closing time and date.
5. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

**Junior Handling:** Conformation and Obedience Junior Handling will be held all 3 days in the first available ring. Registration 10:00 to 11:00 am at the Junior Handling Table. Dogs competing in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or on Exhibition only.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. All Judging will commence at 9:00 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later start time. All Group Judging will commence on completion of Breed Judging within each Group.
2. **The building will open at 7:00 AM each day. The building will be open at 6:00 PM and close at 9:00 PM (Sharp) on Friday for those who wish to set up early.**
3. The Halifax Kennel Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
4. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over their children while they are on the show premises
5. The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these Shows and Trials.
6. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. **(Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules)**

7. No person may approach a judge directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. **(Section 4.1.6, Dog Show Rules)**
8. "Double Handling" will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing so to leave the building.
9. No person shall enter or exhibit a dog under a judge where that judge has owned, conditioned, sold, handled, held under lease or boarded within 6 months prior to the date of the show at which he officiates as a judge. This rule shall apply regardless of whether the judge benefited in any way from any of the aforementioned activities. It is the responsibility of the owner to see that the rule is not violated. **(Section 4.1.7, Dog Show Rules)**
10. The building must be vacated within 1 hour of the completion of daily judging.
11. Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be allowed in the building.
12. **Judging will proceed without any dog not present when called by the Ring Steward. Handlers and Exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers should judging times of their different breeds conflict.**
13. "Puppy for Sale" and "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
14. The Halifax Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
15. There will be no prong or spike collars or flexi leads permitted at this venue. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. There will be no excessive training or playing within 30 feet of the obedience ring.
16. There will be ABSOLUTELY NO THROWING FOOD on the Conformation Ring floors. This is dangerous and someone could easily slip and be injured.
17. Reserve Best in Show – shall follow immediately after Best in Show. The remaining 6 group winners may compete for this award

### **CONFORMATION CLASSES**

Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

### **OBEDIENCE CLASSES**

**Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility (Pre-Novice, Novice C and Novice Intermediate)**

**SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights**

Pre-Novice	for all purebred dogs over 6 months of age.(Not eligible for HIT Competition)
"A" Classes	for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises.
"B" Classes	for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCh. degree or dogs who have earned titles in another country.
"C" Classes	for dogs who have completed a C.D. title in Canada.( Not eligible for H.I.T.competition)
C.D.I. Class	Novice -Intermediate, for dogs who have earned a C.D. title in Canada (Not eligible for H.I.T. Competition)
Open	for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada.
Utility	for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. in Canada.
Exhibition	Dogs 6 months & over, not in competition.

A Bitch in season **may not** compete in Obedience Trials. Entry fees will be refunded **ONLY** if the Trial Secretary BEFORE commencement of the trial receives a Veterinarian's Certificate.

## RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

**Novice, Advanced and Excellent classes will be offered.**

**Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms**

Novice A	for dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Novice B	For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.
Advanced A	for dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Advanced B	For any dog that has earned the RN title.
Excellent A	for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Excellent B	For any dog that has earned the RA title.

**Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 1SECTION 1** - A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

### **Event Registration Number (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN)

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.
