PHOTOCOPY EXTRAS IF NEEDED. IF A DOG IS ENTERED IN MORE THAN ONE CLASS OR EVENT A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM IS REQUIRED FOR EACH ONE

The entry fees may be paid by Cheque, Money Order, Cash or VISA (not Mastercard)

If VISA is used there will be a 10% charge levied per transaction (not per dog). This increase in transaction fee is necessary as the costs of offering VISA have risen considerably.

Faxed entries will be accepted, with VISA payment.

PLEASE READ YOUR ENTRY CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU SUBMIT IT. EXHIBITORS MUST ABIDE BY ERRORS MADE IN ENTERING THEIR DOG(S) REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM THE ERRORS WERE MADE.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY, SUBJECT TO CKC RULES

CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED

The following Official CKC Classes divided by sex will be provided

JUNIOR PUPPY ~ a dog 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY ~ a dog 9 months of age but under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTHS ~ a dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED ~ a dog which was born in Canada

BRED BY EXHIBITOR ~ a dog owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS ~ all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY ~ dogs which have recorded CKC Registration or have an ERN number and have attained the required points for Championship status.

EXHIBITION ONLY ~ Dogs 6 months and over not in competition.

3-6 Mths - Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated a dog awarded **WINNERS** shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING *	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13+

* Includes the dog awarded **WINNERS**. The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded **WINNERS** also placed in the Group. As follows:

A class dog awarded **BEST IN SHOW** at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must (a) earn at least 10 Championship points under at least 3 different judges; and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number (ERN); and, have earned at least one 2 point win either at Breed or Group level.

MOVING UP TO SPECIALS ~ CONFORMATION

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with CKC rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in **WRITING** and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue the request for moving a class dog to specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

REGULAR (R), TRANSITION (T), OBEDIENCE CLASSES BEING OFFERED AND THE CRITERIA FOR ENTERING

(T) Pre Novice ~ For dogs not ready for Novice competition

(R) Novice "A" ~ For dogs handled by the owner or co-owner, or an immediate family member through all classes

(R) Novice "B" ~ For dogs handled by trainers, multiple entries, or dogs who attained titles in other countries.

(T) Novice Intermediate ~ For dogs that have earned the title of CD, CDX, UD and any other advanced obedience title in Canada.

(T) Novice "C" ~ For dogs that have gained the title of CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced Obedience Title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered.

(R) Open "A" ~ All dogs entered in this class must have obtained a Canadian CD. One dog only may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. Every dog in this class must be handled by the owner, co-owner or a member of his/her immediate family.

(R) Open "B" ~ All dogs entered in this class must have obtained a Canadian CD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or by any other person.

(R) Utility ~ All dogs entered in this class must have obtained their Canadian CDX. Dogs in this class may be handled by their owner, co-owner, or by any other person.

ALL BREED RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL

The following Rally Obedience Classes will be offered at this trial

Rally Novice "A" ~ Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler or any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Rally Novice "B" – Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced "A" – For dogs which have won the title of RN in Canada, but have not won the title (Rally Advanced) in any country. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced "B" – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience Title. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title but not the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. A dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class after official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title (R.E.). No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at one trial. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, or a CKC Miscellaneous certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered, or debarked.

BITCHES COMING INTO SEASON ~ REFUND INFORMATION

Entry Fees will be refunded for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trials. To obtain this refund a letter from a Veterinarian must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of the trials.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL MOVE UP

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 9.4.2 and 10.4.2 of the Obedience Rules may be moved up to the next level of Obedience Competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial Secretary, in WRITING, by the owner or handler, one hour prior to the opening of the first trial, TRIAL SCHEDULING PERMITTING.

""REFUND INFORMATION ~ COMMUNICABLE DISEASES""

Entry Fees will be refunded for dogs/bitches that are posing a threat of a COMMUNICABLE DISEASE on the day of the show. To obtain the refund a letter from a practicing Veterinarian MUST be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of the show.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and enter Canada for the purpose of participating in CKC events will require an ERN. To obtain an ERN please do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate, reflecting current ownership, e.g. an AKC registration certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$50.00 plus 6% GSTax ~ in Canadian Funds ~ to the Canadian Kennel Club, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ont M9W 5Z9. Phone (416) 675-5511, Fax (416) 675-6506. Fax requests for ERN are accepted. Please indicate your VISA/Mastercard number, expiry date and name & address of cardholder.
3. Ensure that you provide full return name & address to enable the CKC to forward the ERN to you. The ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day a dog entered a CKC Event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed" (and the listing fee paid), however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days of the Event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores

ATTENTION U.S.A. EXHIBITORS

Prizes will be awarded for the following: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Winners Male, Reserve Winners Male, Winners Female, Reserve winners Female, Best Puppy in Breed, Highest Scoring Labrador Retriever in Obedience and Highest Scoring Labrador Retriever in Rally-'O'. The Executive of the ALRC is as follows: Pres: Janet Bourgeois, V-pres: Trudi Haslett, Sec't: Janice Kivimaki, Treas: Wendy Cook, Director-NB/PE Kim Veysey, Director-NS/NL: Imelda McDonald, Past Pres: Beth Hatfield.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to the commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call the dog to the ring. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC Rules.
3. The Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The Moncton Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left in the building or on site overnight.
4. The building will be open between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Friday 07 October 08. The building will open at 7:00 a.m. daily.
5. To comply with CITY OF MONCTON regulations **NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING**
6. All exhibitors will be held responsible for **CLEAN-UP** on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs and/or dogs they are handling. Additionally, clean up after your dogs at your motel and/or camping area. **PLEASE FOLLOW THIS RULE SO THAT OUR ARENA AND MOTEL PRIVILEGES ARE NOT REVOKED.**
